## **Book Blog Prompts**

- -What connections did you find yourself making to the book, and how did those connections deepen your understanding?
- -What do you infer about the characters? (What did you figure out that the author didn't explicitly tell you?)
- -What predictions did you make, and what did the author do to help you make those predictions?
- -What was the theme or author's message you took away from the book that you could apply it to your life?
- -How might you see or understand the world around you differently because of the book?
- -How would you describe the characters? What evidence supports your descriptions?
- -How would you describe the author's style? Why?
- -How would you analyze the characters and their actions?
- -What did the author do to communicate key ideas, explain a process, or tell a story effectively?
- -What text features or literary techniques did the author use to communicate more clearly?
- -To whom would you recommend this book, and why do you think you would recommend it?
- -Would you want to read another book by this author? Why or why not?

Notice that none of these are simply a retelling of what happened in the book.
